SHOOTERS NOTES

- Chief Range Safety Officer is Bill Black
- Administrative personnel...John Lampert, Ron Slack, Cathy Lampert
- Range officers are CMVFD personnel and are not necessarily firearm experts.
- DO NOT ARGUE WITH RANGE SAFETY OFFICERS. It will jeopardize your attendance at the shoot. Comply with their requests and if you disagree, come see me.
- Sign in and sign liability release. You get your first wrist band
- **MANDATORY** Shooters meeting at 7:30AM Friday & Saturday, and Friday & Saturday noon. You will receive a special wrist band that will allow you access to firing line. Renters don't require either a shooter's meeting or special wrist band. You will need to attend only one although important updates will be gone over the first thing at each meeting.
- Gates for the public open at 8 AM daily. The firing line will open at 9:00AM each morning. It will close at 9:00 PM on Friday night and 9:30 on Saturday night. Fireworks will follow on Saturday night
- If you have a rental or something to sell, identify it on a 3"x5" card and turn it in to staff so it can be periodically announced.
- All shooters (including renters) must have eye and ear protection.
- DO NOT SHOOT OVER THE HILL.
- When aerial targets are present, you must have a spotter behind you to insure your cone of fire is reasonable. NO SHOTGUNS USED ON THE AIRPLANES!!!
- Allow pilot to gain control of aircraft before starting to shoot at it.
- When aerial targets are down, don't shoot them on the ground.
- NO SHOTGUNS USED ON THE AIRPLANES!!!
- Private targets are permitted and should be respected. Must be placed within 100 yards of firing line but no closer than 25 yards. No tannerite, nails, or screws
- All private targets must be approved by Ron Slack!
- No hard metal targets closer than 100 yards. Ricochets
- Don't shoot at targets closer than 25 yards. Markers are at 50, 100, 200, 300, 400, 500 yards. Don't shoot them
- Watch foul language...this is a family event
- No firing cross range. Observe limit flags but don't shoot them.
- Host is responsible for guests on his firing spot. You must control the renters. Watch muzzle sweeps.
- Chain of command. Shooters are primary Safety Officers. Report to your Range Officer.
- **Do not argue with Range Officers. Come see Ron Slack if there is an issue.**
- No open fires. Civil War re-enactors excluded
- Chief Range Safety Officer will control activity on line...air horns, sirens, loudspeaker, paddles, range flags

- Cease fires are scheduled at 12-1, 2:30-3:30, 6-7 for meals and target setting. When they are called, make the gun safe, leave it at your position, and step off your position
- Raffle tickets are \$5 each. Drawing for raffle will be on Sunday at 9 AM.
- During cease fires, you are to be off the firing line & empty chamber indicators in place.
- The line will be run as a “COLD RANGE”. Firearms not being actively used must be unloaded, pointed downrange with an empty chamber indicator in place, and no magazine inserted at anytime except at a firing point. Range Officers are not familiar with all the guns and the empty chamber indicator is an easy and safe way to maintain a safe line.
- When taking a gun to or from the line, the muzzle MUST be pointed down. It must be unloaded and NO magazine in the gun.
- Tracer and incendiary are permitted unless prohibited by Fire Department
- Snakes are in the area, both rattlesnakes and bull snakes. If you're bitten, let us know.
- Range limits
 - Horizontal Do not fire outside of limit flags.
 - Vertical 20 degree elevation. This avoids conflicts with the FAA.
 - No sky blazing with .50 tracer
- Spent cartridge disposal. Pick up your brass. Cattle can't digest it. No other trash in these containers. No live rounds.
- Trash containers are available for your convenience.
- Emergency Medical issues...contact any Range Officer who will contact Chief Range Safety Officer (Tower). Tower will contact MCC Disaster Services located to the south...They don't do mouth to mouth resuscitation, so look elsewhere for sympathy
- First Aid at MCC Disaster Services facility.
- Cameras, media, video. We will have the newspaper and TV here. If you don't want your picture taken, post a sign.
- VIP wrist bands...be courteous to them. They received the band for a reason. Offer trigger time if you can
- ATV's... keep use to a minimum and speed kept slow...Safety & Dust
- No vehicles on firing line when it is hot
- Misfires/hangfire procedures...30 seconds
- Generators OK from 0600 to 2300. Food vendors exempt
- May go downrange (beyond 100 yards) ONLY if you sign out a safety vest from administration (Cathy) Line will not go hot until vests are signed back in.
- Firearms carried to and from firing line must be empty of ammo and magazines. (This is repeated on purpose)
- Personal sidearms OK. Pistols OK on the firing line. Don't shoot yourself.
- Subgun matches on Saturday. Prizes 1st through 4th place.
- Blast shields for .50 cal semi and bolt rifles required
- All machine pistols and sub-guns whose length is less than 18" with the stock folded are banned from public rental or use. Must have fixed stock and 18" overall length.
